

Bonsai Demonstration September 10, 2009

Celebrations in 2009 mark 80 years of Canada-Japan Diplomatic Relations because the Canadian Legation opened in Tokyo in 1929. By coincidence, 2009 is also the 25th Anniversary of the Ottawa Bonsai Society which was founded in 1984.

As part of the 25th Anniversary celebrations, a Bonsai Demonstration will be performed by OBS member, Vianney Leduc in the Auditorium of the Embassy of Japan on Thursday September 10, 2009 from 7 to 9 pm. Admission is free and open to the public. The demonstration will appeal to any person interested in Japanese culture as well as the art of bonsai. The focus of the demonstration will be the transformation of a nursery stock tree into an exceptional bonsai composition.

The Bonsai Demonstration on Thursday will complement the Annual Exposition of the OBS which will also be held at the Embassy of Japan on the weekend of September 12th and 13th. There is free admission of the public from 10 am to 4 pm on Saturday, and from 10 am to 3 pm on Sunday.
